Type 1 Assesses the organization's description of its system and the suitability of the design of the controls for meeting SOC 1 criteria.

Type 2 Assesses the organization's description of its system and the suitability of the design of the controls for meeting SOC 1 criteria – as well as the operating effectiveness of those controls.
